Great Neck USY (Temple Israel in Great Neck) is partnering with Ruach USY to **host the 2018 Ruach Divisional Kinnus** (aka Shabbaton) from Feb. 2-4, 2018. USYers (8th-12th graders,) will be spending Shabbat with us and **we need your help to house them.**

The only thing we ask of host homes is to:

- Host 3 or more USYers (preferably 4) from Friday evening through Sunday morning.
- Provide a sleeping area (beds not required – floor space is all they need).
- Have an adult home when the USYers are there (Fri. night-Sat morning , Sat evening & Sat night-Sun. morning).
- Pick up and drop off the USYers at TIGN: Friday night, Sat morning, Sat night, Sunday morning.

Friday 2/2 10:30pm	Pick up USYers from TIGN
Saturday 2/3 9:00am	Return USYers to TIGN
Saturday 2/3 6:00pm	Pick up USYers from TIGN (if not available, alternate plans can be made)
Saturday 2/3 7:30pm	Return USYers to TIGN
Saturday 2/3 11:50pm	Pick up USYers from TIGN
Sunday 2/4 8:45am	Return USYers to TIGN

- USYers bring their own sleeping bags, pillows, toiletries, etc.
- We provide the food... no need to feed the USYers (unless you want to provide them with snacks ☺)
